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RESUMEN

El siguiente trabajo propone la composición musical para dos cortometrajes, Elephants Dream y Hero de la página web The Cue Tube. Este trabajo busca explotar las habilidades musicales teóricas y compositivas que se han adquirido a lo largo de los semestres, aprender a trabajar junto con un director para que el producto final refleje la conexión entre el cine y la música, y desarrollar una noción del trabajo como compositora en la vida real.

ABSTRACT

The following work proposes the musical composition for two short films, *Elephants Dream* and *Hero*, from The Cue Tube website. This work seeks to exploit the theoretical and compositional musical skills that have been acquired throughout the semesters, to learn to work together with a director so that the final product reflects the connection between film and music, and develop a notion of work as a composer in real life.

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INTRODUCCIÓN

Por esta razón, mi objetivo como compositor es hallar la forma de contar una historia y transmitir el mensaje por medio de 12 notas; a través de la constante lucha contra el tiempo y su evolución que permite planear la correcta forma de reavivar la imagen en pantalla.

Este trabajo pretende plasmar el resultado de este ciclo de estudio, en dónde mis raíces me trasladan desde un guitarrista trovador, hasta un creador cuya intención es seguir en constante exploración; desde lo textural hacia lo melódico, desde el no conocimiento hacia el conocimiento.
